

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Special Session

August 31, 2010 at 5:00 PM

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Present was Council members Grant, Rider, Sacher, and Hagemeister. Councilmember Edison was absent. Also present was Shirley Bowers, and Roger Unruh.

Roger Unruh discussed 3 options the city could adopt, one being the original idea for a 2 ½ year sales tax, with 2 years worth of sales tax going to the street fund, and the other 6 months worth of tax revenue going to the park improvement fund. Unruh suggested that because the amount needed to fix the streets was undetermined at this time, that the sales tax be implemented for 3 years instead of 2 ½. Also, he suggested that instead of designating the remaining sales tax directly to the park fund, that it be reworded to say that the remaining sales tax was to be spent for such other general governmental purposes as needed in the best interest of the city.

Grant moved to adopt Resolution 10-01, a resolution to submit to qualified electors to the city the proposition of levying a one percent (1%) retailers' sales tax in the City of Grandview Plaza. This retailers' sales tax will take effect April 1, 2011 and expire March 31, 2014, if approved by a majority of the electors in the November 2, 2010 election. Motion was seconded by Hagemeister. Unanimous.

Grant moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:20 PM, seconded by Hagemeister. Unanimous.
