

[Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Special Session

October 12, 2010 at 5:00 PM

To consider amending the existing water contract with Junction City

And Notification of Citizens on upcoming election for Retail Sales tax increase.

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Present was Council-members Grant, Rider, Sacher and Hagemeister. Edison was absent. Also present was Shirley Bowers, Jerome Thomas, Roger Unruh, Dewey Terrill, Gerald Bielefeld and Mr. Banker.

A draft of the proposed amendment to the water contract was distributed to the council. Mr Unruh explained the need for the amendment, and the purpose of it, advising the council that he recommended it be approved. **Jack Rider moved to approve the proposed amendment as written; seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.** A copy of the signed contract will be delivered to the Junction City Manager, Jerry Vernon by Honey Grant. The matter will appear on Junction City's next City meeting agenda set for October 19, 2010.

Ms Grant inquired about the best way to inform the public about the need for the 1% sales tax increase question to be on the November election ballot. The council moved to approve the tax increase for a period of 3 years, for the purposes of funding street improvement and such other general governmental purposes as may be in the best interest of the city. The radio station KJCK, and the Daily union will announce the upcoming election special question at various times, and a memo will go on the water billing system this month.

Rider moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:20 PM, seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.
