

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session

January 18, 2011 at 6:30 PM

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present was Council-members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher and Hagemeister. Also present was Shirley Bowers, Roger Unruh, Jerome Thomas, Chief Clark, Officer Peirano, Patti Jo Whitten, Officer Rivera, Megan Moitor, Daily Union.

Rider moved to approve December 21, 2010 minutes; seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.

Jim Gee, owner of the Skyline Liquor Store was present to express concerns regarding a recent break in of his business. The Council will look into the matter.

Jerome Thomas reported on the snow storm cleanup. He still has plenty of Sand and Salt.

Chief Clark distributed his monthly reports, and reported 265 DTF cases opened last year, with 252 arrests. Clark also reported that the police budget for 2010 was under \$27,000.

Rider moved to approve the December Expenditures; seconded by Edison. Unanimous. Rider also moved to approve the December 2010 Financial Statements; seconded by Edison. Unanimous.

Ms. Grant reported that she had attended the Chamber Retreat in Kansas City over the weekend, and wanted everyone to know that GVP is being recognized. Edison thanked Hagemeister, Sacher and Grant for filing for re-election to the council in April.
