

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session April 16, 2013 at 6:30

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present was Council members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher and Rodney. Also present was Shirley Bowers, Roger Unruh, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Allen Crandall, Rick Geike, Dee Corey, Allen Rothlisberger and Jordan Chase.

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Ms Grant.

Sacher moved to approve the March 19 council minutes as written; seconded by Rodney. Unanimous.

Jerome Thomas reported a fire over the weekend. City Hall ceiling was completed and new cigarettes butt cans were ordered. He requested permission to purchase 4 tires for the skid loader at \$1456.04. Motion to approve was made by Rider; seconded by Rider. Unanimous. A proposal from Dennis Sherbert, to do some curb replacement was distributed. Grant moved to approve City Park repairs @ a cost of \$3800, and City Hall parking hall curb repair for \$200. Motion seconded by Edison. Unanimous. The 50th Birthday Bash date has been set for July 13, 2013. Holy Smoke BBQ will cater the event, a super slide and a castle blow up tent for \$150 each, will be provided for the kids. Doug Devin's Band has agreed to play 4 hours for between \$500 and \$600. A motion to approve the plans was made by Sacher, seconded by Edison. Unanimous.

Chief Peirano distributed monthly reports. There were 5 narcotic cases filed this month. Ron's Automotive Repair fixed the upholstery in the Expedition and the Charger for \$350. Bullet proof vests were ordered for Haden and Lytle at a cost of \$762. ½ of those costs will be reimbursed by a grant received every year. Allen Crandall, Michael Baumgardner and Thad Jones have all been hired as part time officers. They are all KLETC certified and will help fill in for vacations and sick leave taken for full time officers. Grant moved to approve the hiring of the officers @ \$16.25 an hour. Motion seconded by Rodney. Unanimous.

Edison moved to approve the March expenditures; seconded by Sacher. Unanimous. Edison moved to approve the March Financial Statement; seconded by Rodney. Unanimous.

Under New Business, Grant told the council that she wanted to form a group called "The 2nd Generation, Yours, Mine and Ours". She is seeking help through her sorority ESA. By-Laws will have to be established, and will be an outreach for volunteers to help with city functions for the children, promoting community involvement. She wants to have a Brainstorming meeting Sunday, June 2, 2013 at city hall at 4:00 PM. She will provide a flyer to the school, and post flyers in the city hall. Edison moved to approve Grant moving forward with this outreach project; seconded by Rodney. Unanimous.

Dee Corey, from Corey's Corral, discussed plans for Live Bull Riding events scheduled for May 17, 18; June 14, 15, July 19, 20, and August 8,9,10th. She will get flyers to post at city hall and surrounding businesses.

Rider moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 PM, seconded by Grant. Unanimous.
