

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular session February 19, 2013 at 6:30 PM

Mayor Hall called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present was Council members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher and Rodney. Also present was Shirley Bowers, Roger Unruh, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Jordan Chase, Gerald Gerloff and Leonard Hume.

Ms Grant led the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

Grant moved to approve the January 15, 2013 minutes as written; seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.

Jerome reported on his department issues. He requested approval to hire volunteer firefighter; Thomas Micah Jr. Motion to approve was made by Sacher; seconded by Edison. Unanimous. Jerome also requested hiring Sicily Landsberry part time to help read meters at \$10 an hour. Motion to approve was made by Sacher, seconded by Edison. Unanimous. Edison moved to approve the bid presented by Ben Kitchens to lower the ceiling of City Hall for a cost of \$18,864. Motion was seconded by Sacher. Unanimous. Jerome will contact Mr. Kitchens to begin the work. Jerome will also be contacting Konza to get appointments set up for the street repairs scheduled this year. He discussed the new dump truck, but wants to wait until 2014 budget year, before purchasing. The sewer machine is lacking pressure at this time, and he is trying to get it repaired. He has had several serious sewer plugs due to tree roots recently. Two bids were presented from Holy Smoking Barbeque for the catering of the 50th Birthday Bash to be held sometime in June. The council wanted to go with the bid that was \$5.40 a person for 750 people. Jerome will meet with them to finalize a date.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly activity report. Office Lytle started KLETC training February 18. A fingerprinting class will be presented by KBI this week. Grant moved to authorize the hiring process for Sherilyn Browns replacement, seconded by Rodney. Edison, Sacher and Grant voted yes. Rider voted no. Motion passed 4 to 1. Vehicles repairs were discussed.

Sacher moved to approve the January expenditure; seconded by Rodney. Unanimous. Edison moved to approve the January Financial statement, seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.

Rodney moved to approve a Proclamation for "Peace through Service" for Saturday, February 23, 2013. Edison seconded the motion. Unanimous.

Gerald Gerloff introduced himself to the council. He is running for the Board of Education. Leonard Hume introduced himself to the council. He is running for a seat on Grandview Plaza City Council.

Sacher moved to adjourn at 7:20 PM, seconded by Edison. Unanimous.
