

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session September 17, 2013

Mayor Geike called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present was Council members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher, and Rodney. Also present was Shirley Bowers, Roger Unruh, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Alan Rothlisberg, Don Greenstreet, Gerald Bielefeld, Kenneth Hall, Chase Jordan, Linda Castillo.

Ms Grant led the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation

Sacher moved to approve the August 20, 2013; seconded by Rider. Unanimous.

Jerome delivered department reports. Lift station #3, needed a new electric motor for \$1500 and a new propeller, cost undetermined at this time. Edison moved to approve this purchase, seconded by Rider. Unanimous. A 20 year old centrifugal pumps needs replacement at the well house, with an approximate cost of \$2500. Motion to approve purchase made by Sacher; seconded by Grant. Unanimous. Twenty potholes were repaired last week. Fifty tons of salt was ordered for winter @ \$41 per ton. Overload springs were ordered for the dump truck at \$376.95. The circus proceeds bought in \$4307.50 in donations to the Fire department. The fire department will be handing out miscellaneous items in bags for Halloween, October 31, 2013, funded thru the donation fund. The school will be having a Halloween Parade on that day, also.

Chief Peirano issued monthly reports. Still having repeater problems; using a loaner for now. Officer Crandall resigned at part time officer due to moving out of the area. Dennison, reserve officer, has resigned, due to other obligations. Sacher moved to replace those officers with 2 new ones, seconded by Rodney. Unanimous. Security Solution's entered a proposal of \$12,190.22 for installing secure doors and cameras for the police department. Rodney moved to approve the bid; seconded by Edison. Unanimous.

Rider moved to approve Augusts' expenditures; seconded by Edison. Unanimous. Grant moved to approve the August Financial Statement; seconded by Edison. Unanimous.

Mayor Geike announced A Town Hall meeting October 12, 2013 at City Hall; with State Representative Alan Rothlisberg, from 10 AM to 12AM. The Speaker of the House is expected to be in attendance.

Edison moved to use Linda Castillo at the city's official photographer. She will draw the same salary at \$40 per month, to be paid quarterly. Motion seconded by Grant. Unanimous.

Rider moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:15 PM; seconded by Sacher. Unanimous.
