

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session May 20, 2014 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher and Rodney. Also present was Janet Young, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Linda Costello, Alan Rothlisberg, Phillip Leamon, Alix Kunkle and Brian Cook.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the April 15, 2014 minutes. The motion was seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Brian Cook addressed the council about the upcoming bicycle tour. Advised counsel would be here at around 3:00pm on 5/31/2014 and leave at around 8:00 am 06/01/2014. Requested the use of the community center. Jack Rider made a motion to allow them the use the community center and waive all fees. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas reported on his departments. Jerome presented a quote to the council for the school lights control box. Marvin Edison made a motion for Jerome to purchase the control box for \$1588.00. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas reported that the skid loader has broken down several times, requested permission to trade it in and purchase a new one. Cost would be \$22950.00 with trade in. Gary Sacher made a motion to purchase the skid loader through lease. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas provided the council with a bid of \$5255.00 from Gustafan concrete to replace the base rock on the South side of the building. Water is leaking into the basement. Jack Rider made a motion to have the concrete work done. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that the lift station contract had been signed and the project will begin. Jerome advised that he was keeping all of the old lift station parts.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports. Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 405 incidents in the last month. Chief Peirano advised the council that the hiring process was still in the works. Chief Peirano showed the council the Bronze award that the department received from the Kansas Chief of Police Association for Officer Haden's' participation in Operation Addabag. Chief Peirano advised the council that he was pricing new tazers for the police department.

Janet Young advised the council of the new RECA contract and program. Jack Rider made a motion to accept the contract. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Janet Young advised the council that a landlord meter deposit of \$50.00 would be beneficial. Marvin Edison made a motion to approve the change. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Janet Young requested a raise of \$.25 for Patti Whitten. Marvin Edison made a motion to give the raise effective on the next pay check. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the April expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the April financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Alan Rothlisberg explained the council about the new schools starting in the area, for online education.

Honey Grant advised that she was planning on the children's fishing event in either June or July. Honey Grant advised the council that the FHRC (Flinthills Regional Council) was in the processing of determining the cost of membership fees.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
