

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session July 21, 2015 at 5:50 PM

Meeting was called to order at 5:50 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Jack Rider, Marvin Edison, Gary Sacher and Robert Rodney. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Linda Costello, Jerry Bielefield, Allan Rothlisberg, and Jason Beets.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Dan Hoffman from PGH, presented the budget for 2016. After discussion the council set a special budget meeting on July 29, 2015 at 5:30 pm.

Honey Grant made the motion to approve June 21, 2015 minutes. The motion was seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports: 1) Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 427 incidents in the last month. 2) Chief Peirano advised the council that John Lytle had resigned. Chief Peirano requested a motion to hire a new officer. Honey Grant made a motion to hire a new officer, Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 3) Chief Peirano requested permission to collect \$10 to \$15 from defect citations to apply to youth activities. Council denied the request. 4) Chief Peirano presented council with quote from Zombie Creek Outfitters. The quote was for ballistic vests that would aid in high velocity rounds that may be shot at our officers. Chief Peirano requested permission to purchase 5 of these vests at the cost of \$1904.75. Honey Grant made a motion to allow Chief Peirano to buy 5 vests at the cost of \$1904.75. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Vote unanimous, motion carried.

Jerome Thomas reported on his departments: 1) Advised the council that he would be spraying the weeds on the streets of Grandview Plaza. 2) Jerome advised the council that West Grandview Drive was in bad shape from the water run off and is literally falling apart. Jerome stated that he would need to replace about 30 ft of curbing, and that West Grandview needed to have new asphalt from State to Plaza and the intersection of West Grandview and Plaza. Advised that Bayer Construction would do 30 ft of curb and 55 ft of asphalt from West Grandview to Plaza and the intersection of West Grandview and Plaza. The cost would be \$28,360.00. Jack Rider made the motion to allow Jerome to get that project done at the cost of \$28,360.00. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that the current salt and sander that the city owns is around 15 years old. Jerome advised the council that he would be asking to put a snow plow and salt spreader on the new truck, with an estimated cost of \$11,405.85.

Janet Young presented Ordinance 15-01, requesting change in the handling of water bills. The new ordinance would repeal all other water bill ordinances. The new ordinance added in, sending delinquent notices to customer, and changed shut off day to the 10th of the month. Robert Rodney made a motion to accept ordinance 15-01. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Mayor Rick Geike presented a bonus check to Janet Young for 10 years of service.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the July expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the July financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
