

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session March 17, 2015 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Grant, Rider, Edison, Sacher and Rodney. Also present was Mike McKone, Janet Young, Jerome Thomas, Chief Peirano, Linda Costello, Alan Rothlisburg, and Beets.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Jack Rider made the motion to approve February 17, 2015 minutes. The motion was seconded by Honey Grant. Motion carried vote unanimous.

Honey Grant made a motion to approve the February 23, 2015 special meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas reported on his departments: 1) Advised that poles marked with orange were put up around the new sewer lagoon property. 2) Advised that the contract has been signed with Konza for the street repairs and they will begin as soon as the weather permits. 3) Advised that the mayor had received information about the National Flood Organization and that he was getting more information on that. 4) Advised that the Easter Egg Hunt will be March 28, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. 5) Requested permission to purchase a air compressor to fill up air bottles for the fire department, advised that it would need to come out of the general fund. Gary Sacher made a motion to allow Jerome to purchase a air compressor from Conrad Fire for \$15, 520.00. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 6) Requested permission to get a new city truck to replace the Chevy S10, from the fire department equipment fund. Robert Rodney made a motion to allow Jerome to replace the Chevy S10. The motion was seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Mayor Rick Geike presented Jerome Thomas with the bonus check of \$300.00 for Greg Quidachay and his 15 years of service.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports: 1) Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 336 incidents in the last month. 2) Chief Peirano presented a salary sheet for the Captain position on the police department that would be effective for 3 years. Robert Rodney made a motion to accept the salary sheet as presented. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Mayor Rick Geike presented Chief Peirano a bonus check of \$200.00 for 10 years of service with city.

Janet Young presented the request from the Sundown Salute for the city to donate \$1000.00. Honey Grant made a motion to donate \$1000.00 to the Sundown Salute. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the February expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Marvin Edison moved to approve the February financial statement, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant advised that she had purchased the business cards with the council members information on them for \$40.00 out of her pocket. Honey Grant requested permission to purchase more of the cards. Jack Rider made a motion to reimburse Honey Grant the \$40.00 she spent out of pocket for the business cards. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Jack Rider made a motion to allow Honey Grant to purchase more cards, and have the city reimburse her. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant wanted the council members to consider having council meetings twice a month to keep up with upcoming projects in the city.

Honey Grant voiced her concern about the customer service at the Boulevard Liquor Store, and the lack of facilities for the Greyhound Bus patrons. Chief Pierano advised the council that Grandview Plaza is not a bus depot and that Greyhound just stops here, knowing there aren't any facilities. Chief Pierano advised that he has attempted to make contact with the Greyhound bus lines and has not had any success. Council members asked Chief Pierano to consult with Roger Unruh and try to get an official letter sent to Greyhound to prevent any further problems.

Gary Sacher made a motion to adjourn. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
