

## Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session September 15, 2015 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Jack Rider, Marvin Edison, Gary Sacher and Robert Rodney. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Peirano, Capt. Mike Rivera, John Day, Jerry Bielefeld Corliss Niethamer and Jason Beets.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the August 18, 2015 minutes. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young advised the council that Jerome Thomas was on vacation. Janet Young reported that the circus went well and the new city hall building was coming along. Janet Young requested a motion for Jerome to purchase 21 bunker blocks at \$50.00 a piece, totaling \$1050.00. The blocks will be used to hold salt in them. Marvin Edison made a motion to allow Jerome to purchase the bunker blocks. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports: 1) Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 500 incidents in the last month. 2) Chief Peirano advised that the Flinthills Regional Council, had received our contract, and was working on locating grants for the splash park. 3) Chief Peirano asked for motion to update 4 in car video systems at a cost of approximately \$26,000 plus installation. Robert Rodney made a motion to purchase the in card video cameras. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young presented Resolution 15-01, which adopted the Central Kansas Region 1 multi-hazard, multi jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan. Marvin Edison made a motion to pass Resolution 15-01. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young advised the council that the survey's were coming along good, and in October would try to finish them up.

Janet Young advised the council that citizens were inquiring about a city wide clean up day. Honey Grant made motion to allow Janet to agree to up to \$600.00 with Howie's Trash Service for the extra pick up. Tentative date of October 20, 2015 set. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Marvin Edison moved to approve the August expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Marvin Edison moved to approve the August financial statement, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Corliss Niethamer requested that the city reconsider their ordinance on the age of mobile homes that could be moved into the city. After much discussion Marvin Edison stated he believed that there was a conflict of interest, due to Honey Grant owning the property that Corliss was inquiring about. Marvin Edison made a motion that the council enter into executive session for 15 minutes. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Council went into executive session at 7:17 pm. Council came out of executive session at 7:26 pm. Marvin Edison made the motion to exit executive session, Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Council advised that no action was taken during executive session. Miss Niethamer was advised that the ordinance on age of mobile homes would stand as written, and thanked her for her time.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
