

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session April 19, 2016 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Robert Rodney and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Jerome Thomas, Capt. Mike Rivera, Redd Dunham, Jason McGlothlin and James Workman.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the March 15, 2016 minutes. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that FEMA had made some word changes to the Floodplain regulations and that we would need to pass an ordinance approving the changes. Ordinance #16-01 was implemented. Honey Grant made the motion to pass Ordinance 16-01, changing the wording in the floodplain plan. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion passed, vote unanimous. 2) Jerome requested to purchase garage door openers for 3 doors with remotes for the city shop. The cost is \$3624.00. Robert Rodney made a motion to allow Jerome to purchase the door openers and remotes of \$3624.00. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 3) Jerome handed out the Bayer Construction quote to repave this years roads (E. Grandview Dr, W. Grandview Dr, and the entirety of State Ave) for a total of \$129,162.00. Robert Rodney made a motion to asphalt the roads as stated for \$129,162.00. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 4) Jerome advised that Luke Erichsen had passed his water test and was now certified. Jerome requested a \$1.00 per hour raise for Luke Erichsen. Marvin Edison made a motion to give Luke Erichsen a \$1.00 an hour raise. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Capt. Rivera distributed his monthly reports: 1) Capt. Rivera reported that the police department had responded to 483 incidents in the last month. 2) Capt. Rivera advised that the new patrol vehicle is in and getting the graphics on it. 3) Capt. Rivera advised that they have hired a new officer, who will start on May 2, 2016.

1) Janet Young presented the contract from Governmental Assistance Services to complete the survey for a total of \$7946.00. Honey Grant made a motion to table the contract until Young could go over the price and amount of survey's left to do. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the March expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Robert Rodney moved to approve the March financial statement, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that he, Chief Peirano, and Honey Grant attended the first showing of the splash park ideas by the K State students. Honey Grant advised the council that the students would be in Grandview Plaza on April 30, 2016 from 1 pm to 3pm to show their designs.

The council requested that Jerome consider conducting one more sweep of the city to pick up limbs. Jerome advised the council that he would pick up limbs until May 06, 2016 when he had free time.

The council inquired about either an outside message board or a new/bigger L.E.D sign. Both Jerome Thomas and Janet Young advised that they would look at some pricing and provide it to the council in May.

Robert Rodney introduced Nicholas Allbritton who will be running for State Senate 17th district. Mr. Allbritton spoke to the council briefly about his background

Gary Sacher made a motion to adjourn. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
