

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session August 16, 2016 at 6:30 PM

Chief Peirano advised the council that they had responded to 431 incidents. Chief Peirano advised the council that Charlson and Dipolito were doing well at the academy and that graduation would be 9-30-2016 at 1:30 pm.

Honey Grant voiced her concern about all the vehicles at 139 E Grandview and asked when 400 Plaza would be demolished.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the July expenditures, seconded by Honey Grant. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jack Rider moved to approve the July financial statement, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Roger Unruh opened the floor for public hearing on the property at 120 Byrd Street. No one was present. Roger Unruh present Resolution 16-08 condemning the property and ordering demolition within 30 days. Jack Rider made a motion to pass Resolution 16-08 as written. Robert Rodney seconded the motion.
