

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session February 16, 2016 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Jack Rider, Marvin Edison, and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Peirano, Chief Thomas, Alan Rothlisberg, Sandy Rothlisberg, Wyatt Charlson, Amy Seals, and Captain Mike Rivera

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the January 19, 2016 minutes. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas addressed the council. 1) Jerome advised the council that there had been a structure fire at 526 E Grandview Drive. 2) Jerome requested to buy a 4X4 shoring outfit for when they have to dig water or sewer lines up. Jack Rider made a motion to have Jerome purchase the aluminum equipment at a cost of \$2951.00. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 3) Jerome advised that Gustafen concrete would be able to fix the handicap parking area for a cost of \$3500.00. Jack Rider made a motion to have Gustafen concrete do the job. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports: 1) Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 392 incidents in the last month.. 2) Chief Peirano introduced Wyatt Charlson to the council. Chief Peirano advised that Wyatt would be attending KLETC in either April or June. 3) Chief Peirano requested to purchase a ballistic vest for Wyatt and two new vests for himself and Officer Williams for a total cost of \$2096.46. Chief Peirano advised that he should get about ½ of that reimbursed to him through grants. Gary Sacher made the motion to purchase the ballistic vests. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 4) Chief Peirano requested to purchase a new patrol vehicle (Ford Interceptor) for a cost of \$48,019.84 for vehicle and equipment. Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the purchase of the vehicle and equipment. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 5) Chief Peirano asked Roger Unruh if he would contact the Greyhound bus and advise them that there is nowhere for them to drop of customers.

Amelia Lewis who is charge of redevelopment of the city park for the splash park introduced herself to the council. Amelia advised that she will be working with K State students and would like to have a town hall meeting 03-08-2016. Amelia advised that she wanted to meet with the community and see what interests the community has. Amelia stated that she would return March 15, 2016 to let the council know how the event went. Marvin Edison made a motion to allow Amelia to use the community center for the town meeting. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young advised the council that the hearing for Nicole Burdick's grievance would be 2-22-2016 at 6:00 pm. 2) Janet Young requested to change the city office hours from 8-5 to 9-5. After discussion Honey Grant made a motion to allow the change as long as it was re-addressed in 5/2016. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Sandy Rothlisberg, the acting president for the Geary County Senior Center invited the council and city employees to come to the Senior Center on 03-22-2016 from noon to 1pm to help deliver food. Sandy also requested that the city sign a proclamation to help raise awareness for March for Meals. Honey Grant made a motion to sign the proclamation. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the January expenditures, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the January financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher made a motion to adjourn. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
