

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session January 19, 2016 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Jack Rider, Marvin Edison, Gary Sacher and Robert Rodney. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Peirano, Chief Thomas, Alan Rothlisberg, and Jason Beets.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Honey Grant made a motion to approve the December 15, 2015 minutes. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas addressed the council. 1) Jerome advised the council that Larson Construction had to be hired to dig sewer line at Robert and Witt, at a cost of \$3500.00. Jack Rider made the motion to approve the expense. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 2) Pointed out handouts from Dan Stewart and the sewer lagoon project, as well as, the updated disaster plan. 3) Jerome advised that Dan Hoffman had told him that there was \$100,000.00 budgeted for street repair in 2016. Jerome advised that he would have a list of streets at a later meeting. 4) Jerome requested permission to find another contractor to fix the handicap parking stalls, council agreed.

Chief Peirano distributed his monthly reports: 1) Chief Peirano reported that the police department had responded to 359 incidents in the last month, and a total of 4839 calls for service in 2015. 2) Chief Peirano advised that he had purchased the forensic computer and for \$11,354.00 which was left from the 2015 budget. Robert Rodney made a motion to approve the expense. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Robert Rodney, Gary Sacher, Honey Grant and Jack Rider voted yes. Marvin Edison voted no. 3) Chief Peirano requested permission to purchase the license renewal for cell phone data retrieval software. Honey Grant made a motion to approve the purchase. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 4) Chief Peirano requested to hire no more than 4 part time employees. Robert Rodney made a motion to hire. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. 4) Chief Peirano advised that he had nominated Captain Mike Rivera for the Crime Stoppers officer of the year and advised the council that he would be attending training.

Janet Young requested permission to attend the Municipal Clerk Spring Conference March 16-18, 2016. Jack Rider made a motion approve the attendance and housing. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. 2) Janet Young requested permission to spend no more than \$2000.00 for a new court computer. Honey Grant made motion to approve the purchase. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the December expenditures, seconded by Robert Rodney. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the December financial statement, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant requested permission to attend the Flinthills Leadership Retreat for a fee of \$175.00. Marvin Edison made a motion for the city to pay the registration, hotel and meal costs for Honey Grant. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
