

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session July 19, 2016 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Jack Rider, Robert Rodney and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Jerome Thomas, Chief Shawn Peirano, Dan Hoffman, Jerry Bielefeld.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the June 21, 2016 minutes. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Marvin Edison made a motion to approve July 12, 2016 special meeting minutes. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Dan Hoffman addressed the council about the 2017 budget. Dan suggested that the city lease to own the sewer machine requested by Jerome and the patrol vehicle requested by Shawn. After much discussion, Honey Grant made a motion to raise the 2017 mill levy by 6 mill. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Jack Rider voted yes, Gary Sacher voted yes, Robert Rodney voted no. Motion carried.

Dan Hoffman advised that he would set the August 16, 2016 council meeting for the public hearing. Dan advised that the floor would have to be opened to citizens on that date. Dan advised that the council could lower the mill levy on August 16, 2016, but could not increase it. Dan advised that the 2017 budget could be approved that date. Dan advised he would send notice to the newspaper for the hearing.

Robert Rodney asked Dan if the city's tax evaluation was to go up, do we have to lower the mill levy. Robert Rodney also asked if the new Kansas legislation locked us into a dollar amount for 2017. Dan advised that he was not sure and would attempt to locate that information for Mr. Rodney.

Jerome Thomas requested to purchase a new salt spreader for \$6158.13. Gary Sacher made a motion to purchase the new salt spreader. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome advised that it would cost approximately \$5300.00 to run the water line under Flinthills for the KDOT project. Jerome advised that it would cost approximately \$4000.00 to bore 165 feet and \$1287.40 for the pipe. Marvin Edison made a motion to approve the boring and pipe costs. Gary Sacher seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome advised that when the air cascade system for his air tanks was tested one bottle failed. Jerome requested to purchase 2 air tanks for a cost of \$1750.00. Honey Grant made a motion to purchase new tanks. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome advised the council that he would be on vacation from 8-5-16 to 8-22-16. That he and Luke would be attending training August 2,3,4, 2016. Reminded council that the sewer project meeting would be by July 26, 2016 at the Curtis building in Topeka, Honey Grant advised she would be attending meeting on behalf of the city.

Chief Peirano advised the council that they had responded to 448 incidents. Chief Peirano advised that he would be purchasing a new door bell system for the door at the police department.

Honey Grant requested that one baby changing station be installed in the upstairs bathroom at the community center. The council approved another baby changing station to be purchased for the city building.

Janet Young presented Ordinance 16-03 (2016 UPOC) and 16-04 (2016 STO) for approval by the council. Marvin Edison made the motion to approve both ordinances. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous..

Gary Sacher moved to approve the June expenditures, seconded by Jack Rider. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant moved to approve the June financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
