

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session April 18, 2017 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Jack Rider, Robert Rodney and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Shawn Peirano, Jerome Thomas, and Officer Joshua Williams.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the March 21, 2017 minutes. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that there were between 35 to 40 children at the Easter Egg Hunt and that 134 E Flinthills will be demolished by the owner.

Chief Peirano advised the council that they had responded to 559 incidents. Chief Peirano advised the council that there is a city ordinance restricting lawn mowers from being driven on the roadway.

Janet Young advised the council the 2016 audit was approaching and requested a motion to have Pottberg complete the audit. Jack Rider made the motion. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Ms. Young advised the council that she was able to locate city insurance through EMC for \$28935.00 compared to Travelers insurance at \$52,000. Gary Sacher made motion get insurance through EMC. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Ms. Young suggested that the roadside cleanup be held on May 20, 2017 from 10 am to 12 pm. Ms. Young requested permission to purchase drinks and snacks for the volunteers. Marvin Edison made a motion to purchase items for no more than \$500.00. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the March expenditures, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the **March** financial statement, seconded by Jack Rider. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Honey Grant asked the council members if they preferred any of the proposals from the chamber of commerce. No action was taken.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
