

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session March 21, 2017 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Jack Rider, Robert Rodney and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Shawn Peirano, Jerome Thomas, Alan Rothlisberg, Jerry Bielefield, Deb, Anders, Patrick Noles, Scott, Long and William Bonjour.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the February 21, 2017 minutes. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Deb Anders from the "Live will" organization addressed the council on the summer lunch program. The program which is funded through grants provides lunches to children 1-18 years old from July 28th through May 31st, from the hours of 11:30 am to 1:30 pm. The organization has requested use of the community center for this project. Ms. Anders advised that she had volunteers that would oversee the lunch program, to include set up and clean up. Jack Rider made a motion to allow the use of the community center. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Patrick Noles, Scott Long and William Bonjour provided information to the council on Bikers Against Child Abuse.

Alan Rothlisburg wanted to set up a date for Roadside cleanup. Janet Young advised that she could have a date for the council at the April 2017 meeting.

Jerome Thomas advised the council that the project in the park is finished, and that the concrete at the community center has started. Jerome advised that the KDOT project at JHill is waiting on Bayer construction. Jerome advised they had hauled off all the old tires.

Jerome provided quotes for this years street project, and suggested that Plaza Drive from Witt to Locust be the priority for \$81082.50. Jack Rider made a motion to have Plaza Drive done. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Jerome requested to purchase a radio bank for the community center for \$463.00. Jack Rider made a motion to purchase radio bank. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano advised the council that they had responded to 455 incidents. Honey Grant asked Chief Peirano about fire pits. Jerome advised her that it required a \$20.00 permit, upon inspection of the fire pit. Honey Grant stated the general public was not aware that they needed a permit. Janet Young stated she would post something on Facebook and at city hall.

Janet Young advised the council that St. Xavier school was having their annual auction and that last year the city provided 1-3 hours use of the community center for the auction. Honey Grant made a motion to donate 1-3 hours use of community center. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous. Marvin Edison asked about the uncleared checks on the expenditure reports. Mr. Edison was advised that some of them would require a stop payment through the bank.

Honey Grant moved to approve the February expenditures, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the **February** financial statement, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Jack Rider made a motion to adjourn. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
