

Grandview Plaza City Council

Met in Regular Session January 17, 2017 at 6:30 PM

Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm, by Mayor Rick Geike. Present were council members Honey Grant, Marvin Edison, Jack Rider, Robert Rodney and Gary Sacher. Also present was Roger Unruh, Janet Young, Chief Shawn Peirano, Officer Joshua Williams, Officer Matt DiPolito, Gary Sith, the daily union, Eagle Communications, Shana Williams and children.

Mayor Geike led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Honey Grant led the Invocation.

Gary Sacher made a motion to approve the December 20, 2016 minutes. Marvin Edison seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Mayor Geike and Chief Shawn Peirano presented award to Officer Joshua Williams.

Jerome Thomas provided list of jobs that were completed in 2016.

Gary Sith presented information on the Joint Land Study that will be led by the Flinthills Regional Council. Honey Grant is on a committee as the Grandview Plaza representative. Mr. Sith suggested an employee of the City of Grandview Plaza to be on a committee as well.

Honey Grant and Robert Rodney brought up the Splash Park. It was decided that we needed more information on the long term cost for the city. Set over to the February meeting.

Chief Peirano advised the council that they had responded to 390 incidents. Chief Peirano requested \$889.00 to replace overhead garage spring. Council agreed that this was needed.

Chief Peirano advised the council that he would be purchasing 4 new exterior vests for \$1352.30 and a new service weapon for \$449.12 from the drug seizure fund.

Chief Peirano advised that he wanted to purchase 300 challenge coins for \$1200.00. He advised that he would attempt to pay for these from the drug seizure fund. Chief Peirano requested permission to purchase these from his budget, if he could not spend drug seizure fund money on them. Robert

Rodney made a motion to allow this. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Chief Peirano advised that the annual Law Enforcement dinner would be held in March 2017. Gary Sacher made a motion to have the City of Grandview Plaza sponsor a table for \$300.00. Jack Rider seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young requested a motion to name Central National Bank, the cities official depository. Marvin Edison made the motion. Honey Grant seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Janet Young requested a motion to renew contract with Delta Dental. Gary Sacher made the motion. Robert Rodney seconded the motion. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Gary Sacher moved to approve the December expenditures, seconded by Marvin Edison. Motion carried, vote unanimous.

Marvin Edison moved to approve the December financial statement, seconded by Gary Sacher. Motion carried, vote unanimous.
