

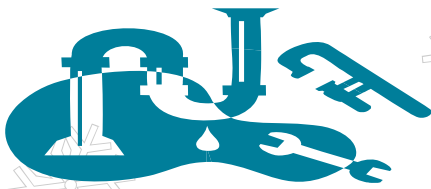
Grandview Plaza Newsletter

Hello Residents!

The City of Grandview Plaza is sending out this newsletter to provide you with information that may be beneficial to you as a resident. Whether you are a long time resident, or a new resident or someone here for a short period of time, we hope that your stay is pleasant.



Once again or should I say still! Cold weather is here, and the Grandview Plaza Water Department would like to remind you of ways to safeguard against frozen water lines.

1. DO NOT REMOVE THE METER LID!

This can cause the meter to freeze and break immediately.

The Water Meter and Water Barrel that services your home is **CITY PROPERTY**. You are **PROHIBITED** from opening this barrel. Should you choose to do so; legal action will result against you. If there is a problem, contact **CITY HALL 238-6673**.

2. Remove garden hoses from outside faucets.

3. Insulate pipes in unheated areas and leave bottom cabinet doors open to allow warm air to reach the pipes.

4. Do not turn down heat in your home when leaving for an extended period of time.

5. Periodically check your heat tapes to ensure proper working order.

6. Make sure each household member knows where the **shut-off valve** is, in case of an interior water line break. Shutting the valve off immediately can reduce the amount of water damage caused by the lines.

Important things to remember!!!!!!!

Water bills are due on the **1st of the month**. If you have not received your bill by then, please call **CITY HALL 238-6673**. The initial bill will serve as the only notice given. If the bill isn't paid by the **5th of the month**, a 10% penalty will be applied. On the **6th of the month at 1:00pm** unpaid accounts **WILL BE** disconnected.

Trash pick-up is on Tuesdays and Fridays. Anything other than **normal** household trash requires a call to **Mallon Trash at 307-4475**. Examples: old furniture, tree limbs and appliances. There may be an extra charge assessed by the sanitation company. Trash needs to be in containers and the containers need to be removed from the curb and returned to the rear of the residence after pick up.

DOG ORDINANCES

Pitt Bulls or dogs that resemble Pitt bulls are prohibited in GVP. All dogs **must** be registered in the City of Grandview Plaza **yearly**. Proof of Rabies Vaccination is required. Having dogs registered in Junction City does not count. The fee for registering dogs is a flat rate of \$10.00 per animal. If you are not sure if your dog/dogs are up to date, please check with **City Hall @ 238-6673**.

Dogs are not allowed to run loose, and must be on a leash or in a fenced yard at all times. If your dog is "**arrested**", be prepared to receive a citation, and pay all boarding fees. Proof of rabies vaccination is required before the animal is released.

Credit Card Payments

The City of Grandview Plaza has changed companies for accepting credit card payments. We are now using State Payments.com. You must come into our office or pay by phone in order to use this service. Online payments are not available. There is a small processing fee added for those who choose to use this service.



Blights are unwelcome guests!!

Please make sure you keep your home area free of unwanted vehicles, trash, tree debris, animal feces, tall grass and etc. We are **very proud** of our city and want it to be pleasant for us, our friends and neighbors and our guests. Blight notices will be given and fines for failure to comply.
